Application of BMS to become a full member of IMU

In the year 1972, one year after the inception of the sovereign Bangladesh through a liberation war held in 1971, Bangladesh Mathematical Society(BMS) was founded by a group of reputed mathematicians of the newly born country with the leadership of Prof. Dr. S.M. Azizul Haque, the then Head of the Department of Mathematics, Dhaka University. Initially an ad-hoc committee was formed for the Society with Prof. Haque as president and Dr. Sheikh Sohrabuddin as the convener. A constitution for the Society was drafted in the same year which later in 1974 was confirmed by the first Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the members of the Society. A complete Executive Committee for the period of 1973-1974 was formed by an election. This process of electing Executive Committee for a period of two years is a regular phenomenon of the Society. The prime goal of BMS is to promote Mathematics education in Bangladesh at all levels from school to university. National Undergraduate Mathematics Olympiad (NUMO)

BMS is also holding Undergraduate Mathematics Olympiad annually since 2009. The aim of the Mathematics Olympiad is to create opportunity for our young talented students in the country to shine and show their Mathematical and analytical ability and to create a nationwide awareness for the development of Mathematics skills. In 2014, BMS has enhanced the scope for the participation in Olympiad by holding six regional mathematics Olympiads where top ten participants from each regional Olympiad took part in the final of the national Olympiad centrally arranged at the department of Mathematics, University of Dhaka, Bangladesh. The holding of these Olympiads on an annual basis is a challenge for BMS which intends to meet with full determination and commitment. Likewise last few years, A F Mujibur Rahman Foundation (A charity dedicated to education) has promised to support BMS financially in conducting the 9th National Undergraduate Mathematics Olympiad 2017 (NUMO 17).
